Hygiene & Safety Concept

This summary version of our Hygiene & Safety Concept introduces the rules and behaviour to be observed at the TuS Düsseldorf 1895 e.V. Rugby facilities (Oberlöricker Str. 7, 40547 Düsseldorf) in order to guarantee everybody's safety. The full version is available in German and English on our Internet site www.duesseldorf-dragons.de and in the club's notice board. This hygiene and safety concept applies to all persons visiting the Rugby facilities of the TuS Düsseldorf 1895 e.V.

Individual self-examination

- Check yourself of any symptoms.
- Do not come if you experience symptoms or have been in contact with an infected person in the last 14 days.

Registration, documentation

- Register on SportEasy before attending each training session or game as participant. Failure to register will deem you unable to attend the training or game.
- All persons entering our premises must register at the entrance.

Access procedure and restriction

- Spectators and accompanying persons are not allowed.

Distance and Hygiene rules

- Bring your own equipment: Bottle of water, towel, surgical mouth-nose covering mask.
- Changing rooms and showers cannot be used.
- Toilets must be disinfected before and after each training session.
- The mouth-nose covering mask can be removed on the way to the pitch and back from the pitch.
- Athletes must wash their hands thoroughly when entering and exiting the pitch.

Sports equipment

- Only trainers or designated persons can check equipment in and out.

Group size

- No contacts allowed during training
- Adults: 2 groups of 20 persons including trainers (immune persons are not counted).
- Children Under 14 years old: 2 groups of 22 persons including 2 trainers.
- Distance of 5 m between each group.

Behaviour in the event of injuries and accidents

- Injury assessment will be handled as usual. The person/s assessing the injury must wear a mask.

Exclusion from training

- Those who fail to comply with this concept will leave the premises immediately.

Don't forget that the official catalogue of fines may be applied to individuals and to the club.
